Checklist for new transfer students

Keep this document for reference.

- I have set up BuckeyeMail and will check it regularly for important Ohio State business.
- I have paid my nonrefundable acceptance fee.
- I have uploaded proof of financial support and the picture page of my passport.
- I have completed all application requirements.
- If needed, I have asked my university to send my final transcript to Ohio State.
- I have run my Transfer Credit Report, read "Understanding Your Credit Report," identified which credit needs to be evaluated before orientation and, if required, contacted the appropriate coordinator(s) to have my credit evaluated.

Congratulations, new Buckeye! Please complete the following requirements:

1. Check your BuckeyeMail account

From now on, important and time-sensitive business communications from Ohio State will be emailed to your BuckeyeMail account. Log in at buckeyemail.osu.edu with your Ohio State username and password (get help with credentials at undergrad.osu.edu/how2buckeyemail).

2. Accept our offer of admission and pay your acceptance fee at appstatus.osu.edu

Your nonrefundable \$100 acceptance fee is due within three weeks of receiving the Acceptance Fee Statement email. However, we advise you to pay as soon as you decide on Ohio State. **Orientation and Housing materials are mailed/emailed in the order fees are paid.**

Note: As a condition of enrollment, admitted applicants are required to answer a question regarding disciplinary and felony history prior to paying the acceptance fee. More: go.osu.edu/community-review.

In addition, all members of the Ohio State community are expected to uphold our mission and values. Accordingly, the Code of Student Conduct (go.osu.edu/codeofconduct) applies upon the offer of admission.

3. Upload proof of financial support and a copy of your passport

Upload the following documents using Ohio State's **Admissions Uploader** found at go.osu.edu/upload. You'll need your username (lastname.#) and password to log in.

- **Proof of financial support:** You and your family or sponsor(s) are responsible for all tuition and living expenses at Ohio State. To show that you can meet the financial responsibility, you must upload a Visa Request Form for each supporter or agency sponsor, along with required documents such as bank statements.

Download the form at undergrad.osu.edu/intl-TR-admitted under **What to do now**.

- **Passport photo:** In addition, upload a copy of your valid passport picture page.

➔ Once we receive your acceptance fee and passport photo, and confirm proof of financial support, we will:

- Issue the appropriate visa eligibility documents (I-20 or DS-2019)
- Email you the **What happens next brochure**, which discusses applying for your student visa, housing, placement tests and preparing for your arrival in Columbus

4. Check your Applicant Center frequently

Check for outstanding documents or fees and provide all required items by the deadlines given.

1. Go to appstatus.osu.edu and log in with your Ohio State username (lastname.#) and password.
2. Click the **Application Status** link in the Admissions section of the Applicant Center.
3. Click the link under "Status."
4. Click the **Application Requirements** tab to view the status of all required items.

5. Submit your final university transcript

If you have completed courses that would not appear on the transcript your university(s) already sent to Ohio State, request an official transcript be mailed or sent electronically to Ohio State as soon as course work is complete. Emailed or faxed transcripts are not accepted.

6. View your Transfer Credit Report and get credits evaluated

If you submitted a transcript(s) from your previous institution(s) to be evaluated for transfer credit, you may have some action steps to take before orientation. Find instructions at undergrad.osu.edu/intl-TR-admitted under **What to do now**.
